

## REGULATIONS FOR AWARD OF POST DOCTORAL FELLOWSHIP

- (a) University Post Doctoral Fellowships shall be of the value of Rs.9500 - per mensem
- (b) The number of Post Doctoral Fellowships that may be awarded each year shall be decided by the Syndicate from time to time.
- (c) The minimum qualification for the award of University P.D.F. shall be a Doctorate Degree in the subject concerned of the University or equivalent thereto. Research papers published in recognised journals will be given weightage in awarding fellowships.
- (d) The application shall be accompanied by a research proposal not exceeding thousand words. The P.D. Fellow shall select a recognised supervising teacher in the Department as a consultant.
- (e) Post Doctoral Fellowship shall be awarded for a period of one year in the first instance but may be renewed, on the basis of record of research work, for a period of one more year.
- (f) The Post Doctoral Fellow shall submit at the end of each year and at any other time when the Syndicate may require, 4 copies of a report embodying the result of his research and at the end of the full period of fellowship, the fellow shall submit a comprehensive report on the work done during the entire period together with reprints of publication if any.
- (g) The Head of the Department shall issue a certificate to the fellow indicating the period of his/her Post Doctoral research and the topic on which he/she has worked.
- (h) Post Doctoral Research Scholars shall choose their respective University Departments as research centres (Syndicate 7.3.98 Item No.107).
- (i) The applications should be forwarded along with the recommendation of the Doctoral Committee
